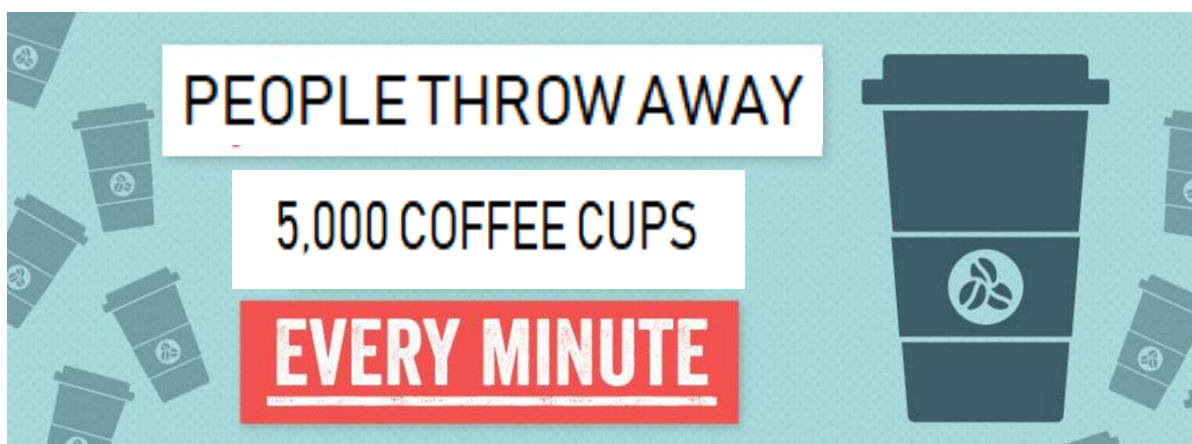

- Used coffee cups are contaminated with drink so they cannot be recycled at a normal recycling plant. We only have three specialist plants in the UK.
