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

Castleferry Sports Centre: Review

Last weekend, I visited Castleferry Sports Centre to go swimming with a friend. We booked a swimming session online in advance, but the staff were unable to find our booking on their system. Thankfully, when I used my phone to show a staff member an email confirming our booking, we were let in. I was understandably disappointed with the bookings service. The sports centre really needs to take the time to ensure that their online systems run smoothly, or they will face similar issues in the future.

Despite these initial problems, the sports centre is an impressive building that offers tennis courts, football pitches, a swimming pool, a basketball court and several sports halls. The prices are extremely reasonable. Swimming sessions are just £2 per hour for an adult, and children swim for free.

I particularly liked the swimming pool, which was well-lit and very clean. The only downside is that with such good prices, the pool was incredibly busy. I think that the sports centre should manage bookings more carefully to prevent it being so busy in the future.



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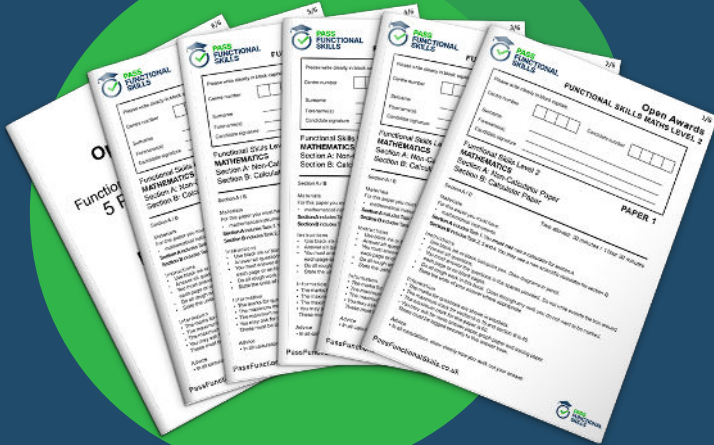

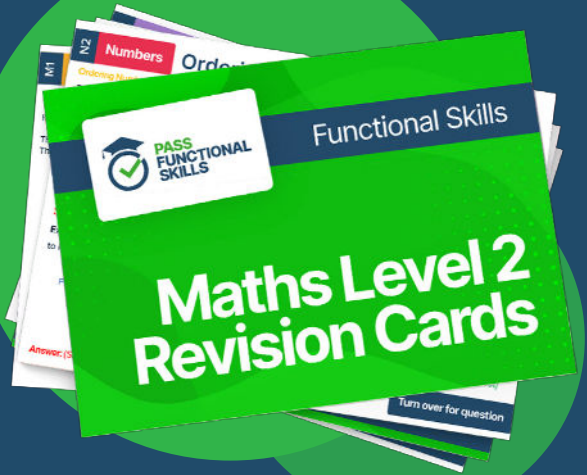




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
