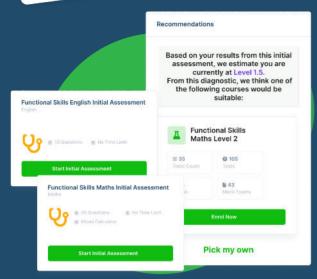

In contrast, Document 2 says 'giving dogs treats is a great way to bond with them, suggesting that dog treats are a good way to improve the relationship between dogs and owners. Document 1 therefore gives a far more negative view of dog treats than Document 2.

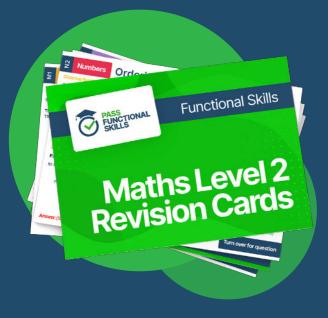
