I saw a young girl leave the bus, instantly crossing the road whilst typing on her phone. Without looking, she walked in front of the bus just as it was setting off. The driver couldn't have known that the girl would step out so soon due to a restricted view, but the bus wasn't going any faster than 10mph. Consequently, the girl was knocked down, and bumped her head on the ground. One of the passengers rang an ambulance, which came five minutes later and took her to hospital for precaution. The driver looked very distressed, but ensured that the girl was in safe hands and that the passengers were comfortable before resuming service.
