What makes *The Lion King* so good?

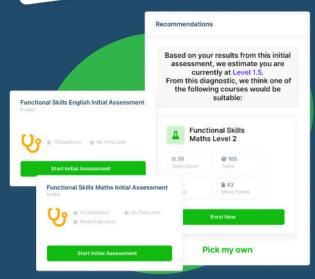



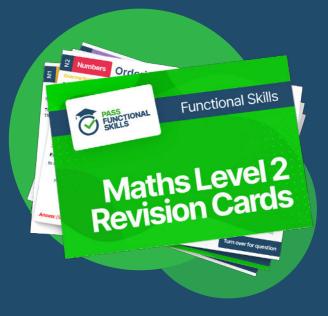
