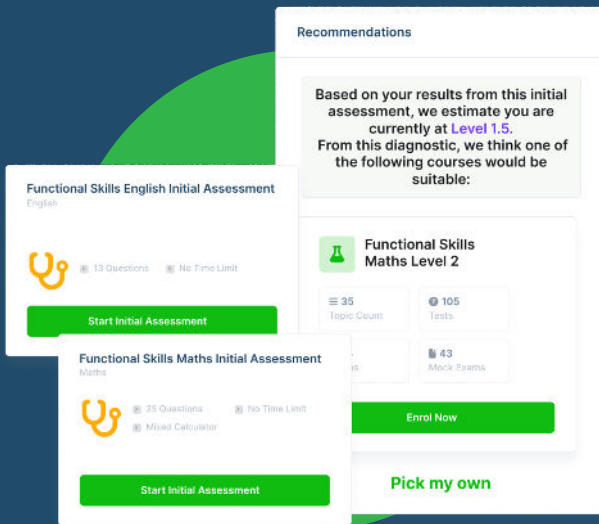
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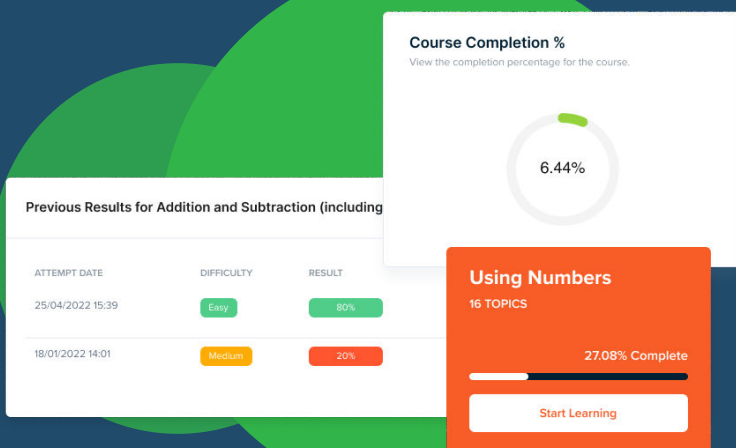
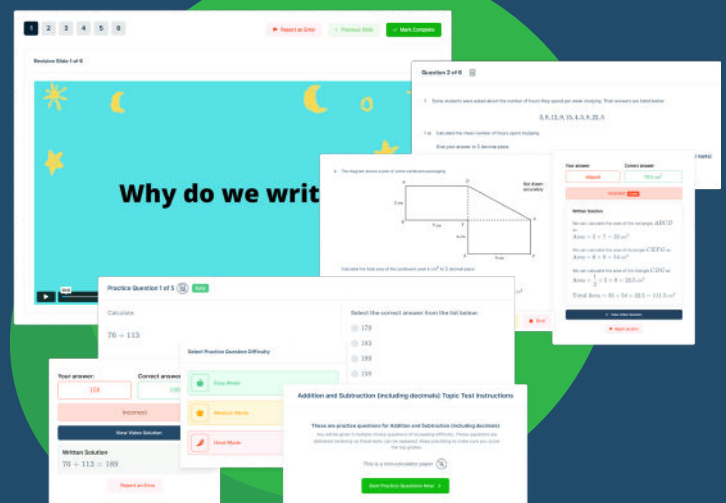

The sibilance used in 'spectacle of sculpted metal animals' draws attention to the metal sculptures to make them more vivid and memorable for the reader.

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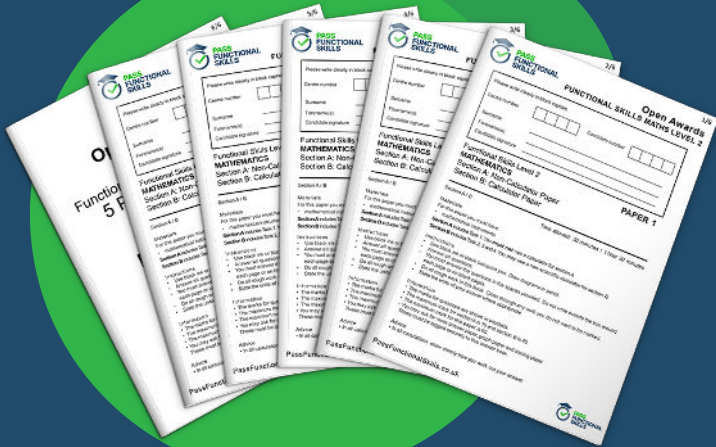




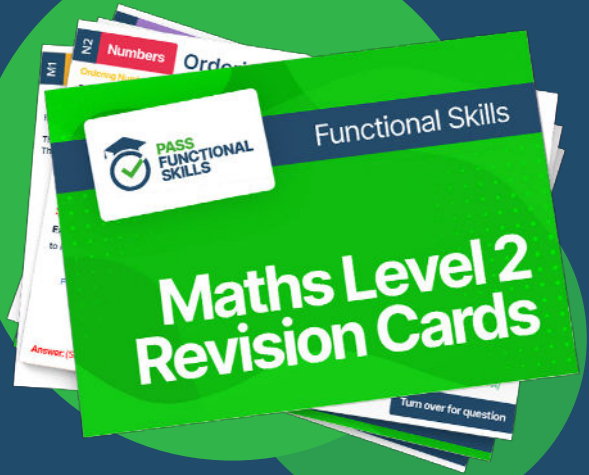




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
